Event basics

What is Sage Enterprise Management Partner Summit?

Answer: This event is the largest annual gathering of Sage Business Cloud Enterprise Management partners for a unique experience that helps accelerate business.

Where is the event being held?

Answer: The Sage Enterprise Management Partner Summit will take place in Dubai, United Arab Emirates at the **JW Marriott Marquis Hotel Dubai**.

When is the event taking place?

Answer: The event will begin on 2 April 2019 and end on 4 April 2019. An optional pre-conference one-day implementation bootcamp will be offered on 1 April 2019 (additional fees apply).

Who can attend the event?

Answer: The event is open to Sage Business Cloud Enterprise Management partners around the world.

Why should a Sage Business Cloud Enterprise Management partner attend the event?

Answer: There is tremendous value in attending! Partners will have the opportunity to learn about the latest Sage technology, network with peers from around the world, gain insights and inspiration through keynote presentations and content sessions created just for the enterprise market, and more.

Registration

How much does it cost to attend?

Answer: Pricing varies depending on the date of registration.

- Early Bird rate of \$1,650 USD, 16 October 20 January 2019.
- Save rate of \$1,950 USD, 21 January 10 February 2019.
- Standard rate of \$2,050 USD, 11 February 1 March 2019.
- Group discount of \$1,550 USD per person for 3+ delegates, ends 1 March 2019.
- Optional pre-conference one-day implementation bootcamp add-on is \$250 USD.

Is a group discount available to partners who bring more than one delegate?

Answer: Yes, there is a group discount for partners who register 3 or more delegates. The rate is \$1,550 USD per delegate and is valid until 1 March 2019.

What is included with the registration fee?

Answer: The registration fee includes access to all presentations and experiences, lunches and evening events. The registration fee does not include travel expenses, hotel accommodations, food and beverage costs outside of the event, and the pre-conference one-day implementation bootcamp.

Will I need to pick up a badge to access the event?

Answer: Yes, you will pick up your badge when you arrive at the event. Prior to the event, you will receive an email with a QR code – you will bring this with you to obtain your badge to ensure a quick check-in. Badges will be available for pickup at the registration desk located in the JW Marriott Marquis.

Are spouses or significant others allowed to attend the event?

Answer: Spouses and significant others may attend the 3 April Partner Celebration event. Guest passes may be purchased during registration for \$125 USD each. These guest passes do not include access to any other event activities. Guests must be 18 years of age or older.

Hotel accommodation and travel

What is the hotel rate?

Answer: The JW Marriott Marquis Hotel Dubai discounted rate for delegates is \$190 USD per night plus taxes and fees. This rate includes breakfast each morning of your stay. You will have the option to book accommodations during the registration process or directly by clicking **here**.

Please note the discounted rate is based on the Dirham rate of AED 700. The conversion to dollars may vary slightly based on the latest currency exchange rate.

Will I need to obtain a visa to enter Dubai?

Answer: Nationals of the following countries do not require prearranged visa for entry into UAE: Argentina, Australia, Austria, Andorra, Belgium, Brunei, Bulgaria, Canada, Cyprus, Croatia, The Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, France, Finland, Germany, Greece, Hong Kong, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malaysia, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, People's Republic of China, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Romania, Russian Federation, San Marino, Singapore, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Switzerland, Sweden, Ukraine, United States of America, United Kingdom with (right of abode in UK) and the Vatican.

An entry visa, valid for 30 days from date of arrival will be issued at the airport in the UAE.

Indian passport holders with valid American Visa or Green Card will likewise be issued an entry visa on arrival in the UAE. The visa will be valid for 14 days and can be extended once for a fee.

The list of eligible countries may vary from time to time. It is therefore advisable to check any visa requirements with your local UAE embassy or the airline that you are using to fly to the UAE prior to departure.
